After this exam you are qualified to teach for any Rescue 3 Europe training provider, worldwide.

WRT e WRT Advanced

We recommend attending WRT and WRT Advanced within a time frame of no longer than one year.

WRT Advanced

Before attending WRT Advanced water, be prepared on:

- Knots, anchors, simple, compound, internal and external tensioning systems
- Practice throw bagging and swimming in white water

WRT Advance e Instructor courses

It is ideal to take the instructor course immediately after WRT Advanced.

In case you cannot, we recommend not waiting more than a year.

In case it has been a year or more, be prepared on:

- Knots, anchors, simple, compound, complex, internal and external tensioning systems, T-method, tensioned diagonals, zip line studied during WRT Advanced
- Practice throw bagging and swimming in white water
- Boat on tethered 1 2 4 points.

Instructor courses

Be prepared for a basic use of applications such as Microsoft Power Point, Keynote or similar



WRT Instructor Training – Assessment Notes



WRT Agency assessment - 4 days Exam

After 5-day instructor course, each student will be assigned 2 theoretical and 2 practical topics.

In the exam, each candidate will have to give lecture on these topics (2 theoretical and 2 practical) and one on knots, anchors, and tensioning systems.

Each candidate will give the lectures to the other candidates pretending they are students.

The minimum time elapsed between the instructor course and the exam is 6 weeks.

After this exam you become an **Agency Instructor**.

You are allowed to teach under the supervision of an independent instructor, who will still be responsible.

WRT Independent assessment - 4 days Exam

The candidate will have to find a group of students, enrol them through a **Training provider**, and organize from A to Z a course under the supervision of an **IT** (**Instructor Trainer**)

The cost of this exam will certainly be a lot cheaper. You have to pay the Training provider and the IT fees, but at the same time the students will pay for the course.

After this exam you become an independent instructor trainer and can work for any Rescue 3 Training provider in the world.

What's a Training Provider

It is a training Provider/centre accredited by Rescue 3 Europe.

One can become a Training Provider even without being an instructor. The Training provider organizes the course and contacts an independent instructor to deliver the lessons.

To give an example: SAFE is a Training Provider. This spring we organized an Ice Rescue course. None of SAFE personnel is qualified as an Ice Rescue instructor so we contacted an instructor from Finland to impart it.
